

MY BODY, MY RIGHTS

To commemorate the *International day for eliminating violence against Women*, the Women Cell organized a seminar titled 'My Body, My Rights' on 25th November, 2021.

The seminar began at 10AM. Rev Dr Thaddeus, Rev. Fr. Xavier, Dean, Student Welfare along with the resource persons were present for the inaugural ceremony. Followed by the Prayer song, Prof. Rekha, Women Cell Co-Ordinator, animated the audience on importance of the day's concept and also presented the welcome address. Rev Dr Thaddeus, Principal delivered the Felicitation address. He began by emphasizing the relevance of the day in today's world and pointed on some of the recent issues regarding female abuses and raised concern towards the same. He insisted that all women themselves need to draw a line, which is the first step to prevent all sorts of violence against women. By the words drawing a line, he directly hinted at voicing out, helping each other, moving her from the confined area to broader space, thereby eliminating fear. He ended his talk by wishing all the students to build up a society where men and women live equally in unity.

The keynote speaker, **Ms Priyanka** was invited for the first session for girls. Simultaneously the boys were addressed by **Ms Rani and Mr Paul Justin Pino**. During the session the following ideas were shared. The resource person talked about *Gender sensitization* and the need for the word gender to be ruled out. She also directed her talk towards child sexual abuse, its mental and physical hazards, how to breakthrough it and take over life as a challenge rather than contempt. Lastly, she also highlighted few points on General hygiene.

The resource person then oriented the students on different sexual identities and preferences. Further they also attempted to clearly show the difference between gender and sex. Followed by it, a small activity was given where students were asked to differentiate between gender specific statements and sex statements. At the end of the activity, there

reflection in which the speaker emphasized on the importance of striking the cultural construct of male and female instead directing them towards the concept of mere biological difference that differentiates human species.

The next topic for the day was *Child abuse and Sexual assault*. The speaker differentiated both and also gave a few examples of real-life experiences of sexual assault. Narrating those, the speaker opened the forum for students to share their opinions on it. The five-finger rule to prevent and deal with sexual assault was mentioned, which deals with identifying the most important people to contact if such a situation arises. Adding on, she talked of maintaining good relationships with parents and friends to share these concerns. A brief introduction on POCSO Act (2012) was also given. The building up of the inner strong person being done passively and psychologically was appreciable of the speaker. A basic idea about contraception, healthy sexual relationships was also shared. The next few minutes moved into menstrual hygiene, the process of menstruation, vaginal discharge, menopause and the usage of menstrual products which were explained in detail.

Addition to this, Ms Rani and Mr Paul Justin Pino oriented the boys about *Gender equity* and *General hygiene*. They also explained about role of power in Gender relationships and how they needed to respect or evaluate an individual as an individual and not on the basis of gender. *Emotional Maturity* was also explained. They were also taught on how to open up and not conceal emotions as it would lead to emotional breakdown. The session ended on how to work in order to have a healthy mind so that we can maintain healthy relationships irrespective of any sex.

The program began at 11.30 am. The resource persons for this program was Dr.Anandhi Krishna, District Program Manager, Vellore, Mrs. Kavitha, District Program Manager, Thiruvannamalai and Mr.Muruganantham ICTC. The main theme of the program was "Celebrating Life and Ending AIDS". Thiruvalluvar University organised this program in collaboration with the Tamil Nadu State Aids Control Society(TANSACS), Chennai. The program was to create awareness about the various HIV Testing Centres present in Government Hospitals, Medical Colleges, Primary Health Care Centre, Integrated Council and Testing Centre (ICTC) and Additional Health Care Centre. Even a mobile application has been created by the organization to get peer consultation.

The Aids can be spread by two ways: 1. Sexually transmitted, 2. Blood donation. HIV is not a curable disease but it can be a controllable disease. Every Colleges must have RRC (Red Ribbon Club) and the members shall be Patron, Chief Patron, RRC Officer, Student Volunteers (two) and the students. Every Year Rs.2000-Rs.5000 grant will be sanctioned by the Thiruvalluvar University to the affiliated colleges but reports (Attendance Register, Photos, Press release if any) need to be send to the university. The ICTC person has given emergency helpline numbers such as 108 is for medical help, police help and fire service help, 104 is for enquiry for hospitals, 102 is for pregnant ladies to get help and 181 is for women protection helpline and 1097 is for HIV consultation helpline.

Conclusion & Recommendations:

HIV patients must be treated as human beings first and should not be isolated in society. A lot of awareness programs about HIV awareness must be conducted regularly. The participants' suggested that it was very informative and requested the organizers to conduct a similar program for youngsters as well. The last 10 minutes were taken to answer queries from the participants by the resource person. The program ended at 4.15 pm.
