Objectives

⇒Enhancing Livelihoods: Empower tribal men and women, aiming to secure sustainable income sources and elevate living standards, with particular attention to empowering women in their roles both within the family and the broader community.



Skill Development: Implement an English Training Workshop for Tribal Tourist Guides, with additional modules for women, boosting their confidence, communication skills, and employability in the tourism sector.



⇒ Promoting Entrepreneurship: Organize an Entrepreneurship Workshop to ignite self-reliance among tribal populations, with a focus on nurturing women entrepreneurs to foster economic growth and gender equality.



⇒ Agricultural Innovation: Offer workshops on Value-Added Products in Agriculture and Awareness Programs in Agricultural Technologies, designed to empower tribal communities, particularly women, to become innovators and leaders in sustainable agriculture.
